Terms and Conditions for Members attending care provision sessions from 1st April 2022

We, Our, Us or The Charity means Kennington Memory Club with the Charity Registered Number 1179830

You, Your, yourself, The Member means a person benefitting from the care services provided by Kennington Memory Club (Club), whose application for admission to membership of Kennington Memory Club has been accepted, or a person duly authorised to act on behalf of that person.

Sessions means care sessions are held in the Kennington Methodist Church on Mondays and Thursdays from 9.30 am to 3.00 pm each week throughout the year, unless such sessions fall on a bank or public holiday and prior notice is given by us that no session will be held on that day.

Fees means £22 per person per session for attendance including refreshments.

Fees Payable

You may attend one taster *session* free of charge to familiarise *yourself* with the services *we* provide.

On the day of your next session a fee is payable to us by you by card (we regret cash cannot be accepted).

Thereafter *fees* are payable in advance by standing order in blocks of four.

Missed sessions

In the event *you* are unable to attend any of the *sessions you* have paid for, no refund will be made, since space is limited, has been reserved for you and cannot be resold by *us*, irrespective of any notice *you* may have given. In the event of *your* inability to continue attending prepaid *sessions* (e.g. as a result of serious illness requiring a long stay in hospital) the *Charity's* Organiser, or in her absence her deputy, may at her discretion recommend to the *Charity's* trustees that a refund may be payable by *us* to *you* for such missed *sessions*.

Meals

Optional hot meals cost £5 and can be arranged by prior notification to the Organiser or her deputy. Meals are ordered after the members have arrived for the session. Payment for meals should be added to the standing order amount in respect of *fees*. If prepaid meals have been missed, carers should advise the treasurer by email the relevant dates and corresponding refunds will be made direct to *members'* bank accounts.

Coronavirus Certification

In consideration of the health and safety of other *members*, staff and volunteers, the *Club* reserves the right to refuse admission to members who are unable to provide satisfactory evidence of protection against Covid-19 in the form of recommended vaccinations and boosters. *Members* are asked to take a lateral flow Covid 19 test within 16 hours of the *session* they are attending, if they can tolerate the testing procedure, and only attend the *session* if a negative test is recorded.
